Ancient History-

This course follows the Ancient history Alveary's lessons and the time period of 350-800 AD. The students will be participating each week in reading, discussing, and oral/written narrations in class. Older children will be responsible for writing narrations. Written narrations will be assigned outside of class, and I recommend allowing at least one composition time in your schedule each week. Compositions are assigned approximately twice a month with an option of feedback/comments for each assignment. As time allows, we will be filling in charts and BOC at the end of each meeting. Occasionally some homework will be needed to complete if unable to complete it in class. Also, some additional afternoon occupations that are provided can be done if the student wishes. Graded exams are included in the course and compositions are optional and depend on the choice of the parent. See fee breakdown below.

The course will have live weekly meetings on zoom as we read the text together. Class participation via discussion boards, assignments, and the schedule will all be assessed through Canvas platform. (which is free) Each student will need an email account to register. You can register using a parent's email account but they will need it to access the course. If registering with more than two children there will need to be two email accounts one for each student.
