

Plutarch-

This course is in connection with the Alveary's Plutarch Lives rotation and will include Julius Caesar and the Gracchi for the 2022-23 school year. In class, the students will participate weekly in reading, discussion, and oral/written narrations. Written narrations will be assigned outside of class, and I recommend allowing at least one composition time in your schedule each week. Compositions are assigned approximately twice a month with graded comments. As time allows, we will be filling in WOW, Virtue charts, BOC, and discussion of character as seen in readings at the end of each meeting. Exams will be given and graded for each term.

The course will have live weekly meetings on zoom as we read the text together. Class participation via discussion boards, assignments, and the schedule will all be assessed through Canvas platform. (which is free) Each student will need an email account to register. You can register using a parent's email account but they will need it to access the course. If registering with more than two children there will need to be two email accounts one for each student.
