Math/Science Club

Course Description: This club is tailored to those who are currently taking Algebra or beyond. The focus age group is 8th grade and up. Part of the class will be working through logic/math puzzles together or working through a math/science challenge. The other scheduled time students will volunteer leading the group in a demonstration of projects being worked on at home or leading in an idea they are working on. The class is set up by the instructor, but the class is student led. Some preparation will be needed when it is their week to present.

Course Design: The students will have live twice-monthly meetings on Zoom. Class participation via discussion boards and the schedule will all be accessed through the free Canvas platform. Each student will need an email account to register. You can register using a parent's email account, but the student will need it to access the course. If registering with more than two children there will need to be two email accounts one for each student.

Course expectations: Students are expected to attend the club regularly, be attentive, and contribute to the class discussion. We have a limited number of spots, so please make sure this is the club that your student is interested in and has a passion to pursue.

High school credits: This will be a great resource to add to your child's transcript as a club in their list of activities.

Supplies needed:

- Canvas account (information sent out during the summer- free)
- Documents printed (provided by Charlotte's Web - free)

Pre-requisites: Grades 8 and up and must be participating in a Charlotte's Web course.

Course enrollment min/max: 5/12

Live meetings- Meets on the first and third Monday of the month at 3:30-4:40 EST.

Cost:

- \$35 for the year, since this is student led the cost covers the fees for the materials and set up of the class.
