Plutarch-

Come learn from a timeless biographer as we learn about the lives of Demosthenes and Cicero, famous orators. In class, the students will participate weekly in reading, discussion, and oral/written narrations. Written narrations will be assigned outside of class, and I recommend allowing at least one composition time in your schedule each week. Two compositions are recommended to be completed within each month for older students, with an option of feedback/comments for each assignment. As time allows, we will be filling in charts, BOC, and discussion of character as seen in readings at the end of each meeting. Graded exams are included in the course and compositions are optional and depend on the choice of the parent. See fee breakdown below.

The course will have live weekly meetings on zoom as we read the text together. Class participation via discussion boards, assignments, and the schedule will all be assessed through Canvas platform. (which is free) Each student will need an email account to register. You can register using a parent's email account but they will need it to access the course. If registering with more than two children there will need to be two email accounts one for each student.

- Commonplace book (notebook for quotes that stand out to the student)
