Writing Club

Course Description: This club is tailored to those who are currently writing a book or have a desire to grow in their writing with the help of their peers. The focus age group is 8th grade and up; however, strong 7th graders may participate if they have mastered the paragraph in their grammar lessons. The class will be split into small groups, so students are able to read their work and have others give feedback and advice. Think the Inklings (the famous literary discussion group including Lewis & Tolkien). The class is set up by the instructor, but will be student led. Preparation will be needed when it is their week to present their writings.

Course Design: The students will have live twice-monthly meetings on Zoom. Class participation via discussion boards and the schedule will all be accessed through the free Canvas platform. Each student will need an email account to register. You can register using a parent's email account, but the student will need it to access the course. If registering with more than two children there will need to be two email accounts one for each student.

Course expectations: Students are expected to attend the club regularly, be attentive, and contribute to the class discussion. We have a limited number of spots, so please make sure this is the club that your student is interested in and has a passion to pursue. Students should be mature enough to be trusted to work independently in their groups when split into separate groups on Zoom. The instructor can not be in every group each week, so please be cognizant of that.

High school credits: This will be a great resource to add to your child's transcript as a club in their list of activities.

Supplies needed:

- Canvas account (information sent out during the summer- free)
- Documents printed (provided by Charlotte's Web - free)

Pre-requisites: Grades 8 and up and must be participating in a Charlotte's Web course.

Course enrollment min/max: 6/12

Live meetings- Meets on the second and fourth Monday of the month at 3:30-4:40 EST.

Cost:

- \$35 for the year, since this is student led the cost covers the fees for the materials and set up of the class.
